

DHCP Relay

relay

This command specifies the DHCP relay address to which DHCP requests in this VLAN will be redirected.

The negative form of the command removes the specified address.

Syntax

```
[no] relay <IP>
```

Parameters

<IP> - IP address in format of XXX.XXX.XXX.XXX

Command mode

CONFIG

Example

```
ma4000(vlan-100)# relay 172.15.2.45
```

ip interface

This command sets the address of the subinterface from which DHCP packets in this VLAN will be sent.

The negative form of the command removes the specified address.

Syntax

```
[no] ip interface <IP>
```

Parameters

<IP> - IP address in format of XXX.XXX.XXX.XXX

Command mode

CONFIG

Example

```
ma4000(vlan-100)# ip interface 172.15.3.64
```
